 Working in the social sciences Employed with the University of Vienna (subject to an employment contract of 50 % or more) Consent to the <u>Code of</u> <u>Good Practice for Doctoral Schools</u> Participation in the activities organised by the Doctoral School 	 Enrolled in the doctoral programme in Social Sciences At least one supervisor who is a member of the ViDSS Consent to the <u>Code of Good Practice for Doctoral Schools</u> Temporary membership for 9 months, after which doctoral candidates should complete the public presentation at the Faculty (FÖP); an extension is possible to a maximum of 12 months Regular submission of progress reports Participation in the activities organised by the ViDSS Regular participation in a PhD Club Participation in a workshop, ViDSS Brownbag Session or other activities at least once a year Presentation of the doctoral thesis project in the form of a departmental or faculty-wide lecture or at an international conference at least once during the first three years of doctoral studies
